



2020 Environmental Art Award – City-wide Exhibition

TERMS & CONDITIONS

1. Registration/s must be submitted to BHAE by midnight on Wednesday 16th September 2020. A .jpeg of the artwork or the work in progress must be attached and late entries will not be accepted.
2. Entrants must arrange their own exhibition space *in Broken Hill*. The space must be viewable during a **minimal viewing time of 9am-5pm, Monday to Friday**. (Eg, displayed in a shop window; displayed in your front yard, etc) All necessary authorities and permissions to display artwork(s) at the nominated display site must be obtained from the proprietor of that site.
3. The charging of any fees or favours to view the work is not permissible under any circumstances.
4. The artist(s) are responsible for the organising, installing, hanging, maintenance, any penalties incurred, security, safety, de-installing and removal of the artwork(s) at the display site/s.
5. Broken Hill Art Exchange accepts no responsibility for any damage, liability or injury incurred by the artist, site proprietor, or the public in the installation, display, and removal of the artwork/s.
6. Artworks must be installed by 26th September and remain displayed for the duration of the exhibition and removed from the site after 4pm Sunday 10 November 2019.
7. Submitted artworks can be for sale by the entrant. The Broken Hill Art Exchange accepts no responsibilities for commissions or the sale of artworks. **To be eligible for a prize the artwork(s) must be displayed in its original form throughout the exhibition period.**
8. An entrant under 18 years of age is not eligible for Youth Encouragement Award if awarded a major prize.
9. There is no limit to how many works may be entered, but each work entered must have a separate registration form and separate image with any applicable fee paid.
10. **Entries must be original works by the entrant/s not previously exhibited.**
11. By signing the registry form you acknowledge that details and imagery of the entry may be used and reproduced by BHAE for promotional and publicity purposes on its website at www.brokenhillartexchange.org.au and in printed publications (with the exception of any personal details provided in the registry form). In this event, BHAE will credit the artist(s) appropriately.
12. The competition is open to all art forms.
13. The entrant named in question 1a is responsible for individual & group entries and the distribution of prize winnings. If the entrant is under 18, the parent / guardian named in the registration form will be the primary contact for correspondence and is responsible for these Terms and Conditions.
14. The Broken Hill Art Exchange reserves the right to reject and withdraw any artwork(s) from the exhibition & prize at its discretion.
15. All costs associated with entering and exhibiting artworks as part of the exhibition & prize are to be met by the entrant(s)
16. The decision of the judges and those by the Broken Hill Art Exchange are final and no correspondence will be entered into after the final judging.
17. The judges reserve the right not to award a prize category if they see fit.
18. An entry will be deemed ineligible if unpaid or not accompanied by an image.
